Kindergarten, First Grade and Second Grade (K-2) Weekly Schedule KEY

The K-2 schedules have a mix of whole group, half class and small group learning opportunities.

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday are the primary instructional days.

Wednesday is a catch-up day for students with only the movement block for kindergarten students.

Half Class: A block of time scheduled for about 50% of students enrolled in the class

A and B: Denotes a half class sessions (A and B assignments will be communicated on August 24th)

Small Groups with a #: Denotes groups of 3-6 students that will be scheduled in cycles throughout term 1 (the first small group cycles and the overall cycle schedule will be emailed on August 24th)

Independent Math/Responsive Groups: This includes some asynchronous lessons, independent work time, and groups that are dependent on in-the-moment student learning needs. Depending on their needs, all students will be engaged in one or several of these forms of learning during these blocks.
