DCPS's summer learning program is open for registration. Parents can sign up by going to <https://dcps.dc.gov>, Academic Programs, Summer@DCPS, Summer Learning. This summer's site for Ward 6 is Payne Elementary, 1445 C St. SE. The program will run on weekdays from June 26th to July 28th, 8 a.m. - 1 p.m. Low-cost after-care is provided until 6 p.m. Registration is free, along with the

program, which includes breakfast and lunch daily. Parents need to submit their student's DCPS ID to register. DCPS Summer School instruction is pitched at grade level, with some differentiation in the classroom.
